## Creation Days 5 - 6

Scripture: Genesis 1:20-31; Genesis 2

### Day # 5 – Genesis 1:20 - 23

- Fish – vs. 21
- Birds – vs. 21



### Created Things and Age:

The universe was mature when it was created. God created it with the appearance of age.

When He created trees and animals, He created them as mature, fully developed organisms.

- Trees with already mature fruit - Genesis 1:11
- Adam was created full grown and capable of marriage and reproduction - Genesis 1:27,28
- Birds filled the sky not just the nests - Genesis 1:20
- When dealing with things created, evidences of maturity or signs of age do not constitute proof of age.
- Oak tree would have (fruit) acorns and may have had growth rings



### Day # 6 – Genesis 1:24 - 31

- Land animals – vs. 25 (Dinosaurs)
- Man and woman – vs.27



When God repeats something, we should listen

- In the creation account God repeats ten times that the living things He created were created according to their kinds

“KIND “*According to its kind*”

Genesis 1 verses 11, 12, 21, 24, 25

- The created kinds can be most closely described as families of animals
- God first used the term in Genesis one
- God uses the term again when He instructed Noah to take two of every kind of animal onto the Ark (Genesis 6:20)

By using this word every time procreation is mentioned in the Genesis account underscores the truth that evolution denies: When living creatures reproduce, they can produce only creatures similar to themselves.

- This does not teach against mutations or the development of various breeds within a specie

Since the beginning of earth’s history, there have been many different kinds (families) of animals

- Each distinct from one another
- An animal or plant from one family has never turned into an animal or plant from another family
- There has never been evidence of one kind of animal ever changing into a completely different kind of animal

### God’s Work of Creation is Complete – Genesis 2 vs. 1

The first chapter of Genesis gives a summary of the events on all six days of creation; the second chapter provides more details of certain events of the sixth day

Genesis 2 emphatically states that God had finished all the work of creation

- This argues strongly against the evolutionary teaching that creation is a work still in progress

Genesis 2:4 – This is the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created

- This is not a contradiction of chapter one, but a detailed description of day six

### God rests the seventh day – vs. 2, 3

God did not rest because He was tired, but His work of creation was complete

### Review of what had transpired – vs. 4-9; 15-25

This section fills in the details of creation on the sixth day

2:4 – “*LORD God*” – First mention of the word LORD (YHWH)
