1. The Question asked by Jesus

Question Jesus asked to the Scribes and Pharisees after condemning their actions Matthew 23:33 – "How can ye escape the damnation of hell?"

Gehenna – Refers to the valley of Hinnom near Jerusalem, a garbage dump where fires constantly burned.

Place in the OT where apostate Jews sacrificed infants to the false god, Molech

2. The Seriousness emphasized by Jesus Mark 9:43-48

⁴³And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: ⁴⁴Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

⁴⁵And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: ⁴⁶Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. ⁴⁷And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire: ⁴⁸Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

The lost are always exposed to sudden unexpected judgment. As the lost walk in slippery places every moment liable to fall, he cannot foresee one moment whether he shall stand or fall the next; and when he does fall, he falls at once without warning.

1. There is no lacking of power in God to cast the lost into Hell at any moment

- 2. The lost deserve to be cast into Hell and divine justice never stands in the way, it makes no objection against God using His power at any moment to punish the wicked
- 3. The lost are already under a sentence of condemnation to Hell (John 3:18)
- 4. The lost are now the objects of that same anger and wrath of God, that is expressed in the torments of Hell
- 5. The devil and his demons stand ready to fall upon the lost, and seize them as their own, at what moment God shall permit them
- There are in the souls of wicked men those hellish principles reigning, that would presently kindle and flame out into Hell fire, if it were not for God's restraints
- 7. It is no security to the lost for one moment, that there are no visible means of death at hand
- 8. God has not laid Himself under any obligation, by any promise, to keep any lost man out of Hell one moment
